



This image was about the destruction of streets and the thrilling escape of people when Mount Vesuvius erupted in Pompeii in AD 79. Pompeii is one of the ancient Roman cities, located at the foot of Mount Vesuvius in the Bay of Naples, Italy. It is where the Greeks and Phoenicians lived. Mount Vesuvius erupted after a week of several signs of volcanic activity. The city of Pompeii was buried alive in volcanic ash more than six meters deep overnight. The speed of the volcanic lava was so fast that people panicked, had no way to escape, and were eventually buried alive. In 1599, the ancient wall with carvings was discovered due to the opening of the underground water channel. Pompeii was rediscovered in 1748 by the Naples royal family, but they only excavated ancient treasures to decorate their palaces. In 1997, the archaeological area of Pompeii was listed as a World Heritage Site.
